- 2. Grant is released to the above-mentioned organizations subject to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions:-
- (i) The grantee organizations/individuals shall acknowledge the financial support provided by the Ministry of Culture through banners, posters, invitation cards, print as well as audio media, while organizing the programme under the Performing Arts Grant Scheme.
- (ii) The Utilization Certificate along with two copies of audited statement of Accounts and an extract of Assets Register containing progressive figures (both stores and value) shall be submitted by the grantee to National School of Drama, New Delhi within twelve months from the date of issue of the sanction.

- (iii) If any grantee Organization/individual fails to submit the Utilization Certificate (U.C.) of the grant within twelve months of the closure of the financial year in which the sanction is issued, they will be considered as blacklisted and debarred for receiving any future financial assistance.
