# Minutes of the National Selection Committee Meeting under the Scheme of Tagore National Fellowship for Cultural Research (TNFCR), Batch Year 2019-20

The meeting of the National Selection Committee (NSC) for Tagore National Fellowship for Cultural Research (TNFCR) was held on 27<sup>th</sup> September (Group A & B) and 28<sup>th</sup> September (Group C & D) 2022 in the Seminar Room of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library (NMML), New Delhi under the Convenorship of Secretary (Culture) to consider the proposals for the selection of Fellows/Scholars for the batch 2019-20, proposals to review the Sixth Monthly/Final Reports of the previous batches of Fellows/Scholars and issuance of advertisement for the year 2020-21. The list of attendees of the meeting is placed at **Annexure I**.

At the outset, Smt. Amita Prasad Sarbhai, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Culture (P. Arts & ZCC/Bureau), welcomed Secretary (Culture) and members of the Committee.

Thereafter, Secretary (Culture) discussed the salient features of the scheme, such as its inception in 2009, its aims and objectives and also mentioned that the delay in selection process, which has ocurred due to the COVID-19 may now be covered up by expediting the selection process. He concluded his opening address by thanking all the NSC members and institutions for their cooperation and support.

#### **Decisions:-**

The committee thereafter discussed in detail all agenda items and took the following decisions:

1. <u>Item 2</u> - Approval of the compliance report of the NSC meeting held on  $26^{th}$  - $27^{th}$  February 2020

# Item 3 – Agenda for Selection of Candidates for Tagore National Fellowship and Scholarship

The NSC considered the applications received through participating institutions under the scheme. The committee examined 140 shortlisted applications (Fellowship - 61, Scholarship - 79) and recommended 9 applications for Fellowships and 23 applications for Scholarships for two years tenure. 108 applications have not been recommended. The

list of recommended and not recommended applications is at **Annexure-III** and **Annexure-III** respectively.

#### 3. Item 4 – Six Monthly Reports of Fellows/Scholars to be reviewed by the NSC

The committee considered Six-monthly/Final reports of 69 Fellows/Scholars (Group A - 18, B - 15, C - 21 and D - 15) and approved all the Reports. Besides this, the committee considered one more report of a Fellow as an additional agenda and the same was also approved. The list of approved six monthly/final Reports of 70 Fellows/Scholars is placed at **Annexure-IV**.

#### 4. Item 5 - Issuance of advertisement for Batch Year 2020-21

The NSC approved the issuance of advertisement for the two Batch Years i.e. 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 with a view to remove the backlogs.

#### 5. <u>Item 6</u> – Other recommendations of the NSC:-

- a. The committee recommends to give one year extension to Dr. Kshetrapal, Tagore Fellow, Allahabad Museum to submit the final report without any additional financial support due to his health issues (COVID).
- b. All the nodal institutions are required to review all the reports of the awardees of Fellowship/ Scholarship through their ILSSCs and then send it to the NSC with their observations.
- c. Nodal institutions need to ensure the credibility/ originality of the research work before sending it to the NSC. The progress reports should contain the details of chapters and relevant bibliography and other aspects.
- d. All the institutions are required to examine carefully the recommendations of ILSSC on the receivede applications before forwarding the same to NSC.
- e. The proposals must be in a proper format including research problem, objectives, literature review, hypothesis, methodology, chapterisation and bibliography. Nodal institutions are supposed to do more rigorous scrutiny of every proposal.
- f. The observations/ remarks of ILSSC must be enclosed with each and every application.
