NOTIFICATION

GSR ----- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the National Research Laboratory for Conservation of Cultural Property (Group 'B' Ministerial, Gazetted post) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1993 relating to the posts of Junior Administrative Officer, NRLC Lucknow, the President hereby makes the following recruitment rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group B (Ministerial, Gazetted post of Junior Administrative Officer of National Research Laboratory for Conservation of Cultural Property, Lucknow as specified in the column 1 of the Scheduled appended hereto namely-

1. Short title and commencement

- (1) These rules may be called the National Research Laboratory for Conservation of Cultural Property Group 'B' Ministerial (Gazetted) post Recruitment Rules 2023.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay

The number of the said post, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification, etc.

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification: No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

5. Power to relax

Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
