Subject:-Grant-in-aid to Government of Goa for non-recurring Plan expenditure (2014-15) for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) in connection Renovation of Ravindra Bhawan & 2nd phase construction of Ravindra Bhawan at Curchorem, Goa under TCC Scheme.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakh only) as the Central Government's share of non-recurring Plan expenditure to the Government of Goa for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) in connection with Renovation of Ravindra Bhawan & 2nd phase construction of Ravindra Bhawan at Curchorem, Goa, under the Scheme for Tagore Cultural Complexes.

2. It is certified that the above amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakh only) is being paid in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid Scheme.
3. This amount would be adjusted by way of deduction from the first instalment which would be released in future.
4. The funds may be utilized for preparation of Detailed Project Report(DPR) only and the same may not be diverted for any other purpose.
5. The grantee organization would be bound to submit the Detailed Project Report(DPR) to the Director, National School of Drama, Bahawalpur House, Bhagwan Dass Road, New Delhi-110001 within a period of 2 months from the date of release of grant.
6. Separate accounts shall be maintained in respect of the grants released by the Government of India under this sanction order.
7. The accounts and the site of the project shall be open for inspection by the representatives of the Ministry of Culture at any time for verification.
8. The accounts of the organization will be open to audit at any time by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India or his nominees at his discretion.

9. The project may be taken up in phases. The first phase may be at a cost of Rs.15.00 crore out of which Rs.9.00 crore would be the Central Government share.

10. **The above amount is debitable to Demand No. 19 – Ministry of Culture, 3601 – (Major Head) Grant-in-aid to State Governments, 03 – (Sub-Major Head) Grants for Central Plan Schemes 201 – (Minor Head) Promotion of Art & Culture, 09 Tagore Cultural Complexes, 09.00.35 – Grants for Creation of Capital Assets, for the current financial year 2014-15.**

11. The amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakh only) will be placed at the disposal of the State Government by the Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of Culture, through RBI, Central Accounts Secretariat, Nagpur, as early as possible, but in any case not later than 31.03.2015.

12. The above sanction is issued in exercise of the delegated powers and in consultation with IFD vide their Dy. No. 2993 dated 12.11.2014.

13. Grant sanction has been entered in the Grant-in-aid Register at Sl. No.4.


