Abstract: What would your birthday celebrations look like on the moon?

In this interactive workshop learners experience the laws of physics first hand by embodying different degrees of gravitational forces. The workshop begins with a short mime-theatre piece about space travel. Learners then learn mime and physics to decipher and better understand the natural laws that govern our world.

This workshop was devised as collaboration between the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology and the Norwegian "SPACE-ME" project which aimed to increase children's awareness of and engagement with space. It has since been conducted with school children, teachers, university students and artists in Norway, Israel, Iceland and Hungary.
