There are 120 oil paintings which had been created by Shri Shrikant Chougule and his son Shri Gautam Chougule who took 15 years to complete the work.

The show has been conceptualized and curated by Deepak Gore under the guidance of Babasaheb Purandare, who is a mentor, an eminent writer and theatre personality from Maharashtra. His works are largely focused on the life of Shivaji, the founder of Maratha empire in the 17th century.
