LECTURE HIGHLIGHTS

Pahari School Ramayana drawings of Ayodhya Kanda is a newly discovered set of drawings by me which gives a day to day account in as many as 62 folios, beginning with the announcement of Rama's coronation by his father King Dasharatha, and the tragic events which enfolded with Kaikeyi's stubborn behavior leading to Rama's exile to the forest for the next 12 years, with Sita and Lakshaman insisting on joining him, the consequent death of Dasharatha, Rama's brother Bharata's refusal to be the next King, his journey to the forest to persuade Rama to return, but comes back with his khaduan, which he installs as the King Ayodhya.

The drawings are so unique because of the parallels with the language of cinema. This Power Point Presentation with 62 folios will be of much interest to those studying Film and Animation.
