

Through interesting Vedic chants and ancient Manipuri rituals, Mei is invoked, shown in relation to earth, fire, water and sky and finally, as a purifier and remover of all evil. The Vedic and Manipuri traditions come together through contemporary choreography of the Manipuri Male Dance forms- especially **Thang-Ta**, the martial art form.
