 - b. Issue instructions to display the creatives (the open files of the creatives will be shared shortly) on:
 - ✓ official websites of your Ministry and it's associate offices,
 - ✓ prominent locations in all subordinate offices at various levels,
 - ✓ prominent places in all the institutions functioning under the aegis of your Ministry,
 - ✓ Moreover, you may adopt other innovative measures to propagate and promote this significant initiative of Hon'ble Prime Minister towards reducing exam stress.
 - c. Ensure all creatives and directions are sent through email and social media to all your institutions and educational administrators through your office, and through institutions to all parents/students.

- g. Students will be selected in states/UTs. States have been requested to issue instructions to SCERT or equivalent organization in the States/UTs, to carry out the selection process subject to allocated quota (Annexure-II) in coordination with NCERT. States and UTs have also been requested to ensure that selected participants reach District / State or UT headquarters on the specified date, as may be decided.
- i. Students selected to participate directly in the main event of Pariksha Pe Charcha 2021 shall be rewarded with a special kit. This may also be disseminated.
