- Disposal of obsolete items and e-waste to be done
- Outdoor and Indoor plants may be placed in and around the offices premises
- The entry and exit of buildings like Monuments, Museums, Libraries and Art galleries etc. should be clean, green and easily accessible for all.
- Regularly wash or sanitize your hands
