Member Secretary of the Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), Dr. Sachchidanand Joshi remembered the time he spent with her and said she was a great scholar who tried to bring all art forms on a single dais. She herself was like a Saraswati whose knowledge and intellectuality needs to be respected every time. Famous Sanskrit writer, Prof. Radhavallabh Tripathi remembering his first meeting with her in 1971 during World Sanskrit Sammelan and said Kapilaji was widely praised for Jayadev's *Geeta Govindam* in different Indian Dance Art forms. While remembering her Vavidhyapurn status, he said that she was a great scholar always brought Indian culture alive. Famous English writer, Prof. Malashri Lal while mentioning her work on Geeta Govindam said that during performance in Darbhanga, she was enlightened with her vast knowledge. Sukrita Paul Kumar, a famous writer remembered her as her second mother said that her achievements were not possible without scholarly knowledge. She also mentioned that she always praised the suggestions and welcomed knowledge. She is not with us today but her vision will always by a path for us.

Eminent Educationist, Chander Mohan called her a role model of Indian culture who created different forms for discussion. Vice President of Sahitya Akademi, Sri Madhav Kaushik said that she was an undeclared ambassador of Indian culture. She herself was an institution who made awareness and sympathy about politics and culture. He mentioned about her work on compilation of Vasudevsharan Aggarwala in Hindi and English showed how much she truly respected her teachers. The eminent dancer Sonal Mansingh in her condolence message to Sahitya Akademi said that Kapila ji was an important face of Indian Art forms and was always worked a bridge between the Government and the artisans. She created many important art institutions in India. Kapila ji will be loved and remembered by Indians who love India.
